### **Build Your Own Boat Race Rules**

- 1. Registration
  - a. All teams must submit a completed registration form AND liability waiver(s)
  - b. All teams must pay the race entry fee of \$50.00
  - c. All teams must check-in on race day with race officials
  - d. All teams must review race route map
- 2. Boat building teams can have a maximum of four (4) crew members. The finished boat can only be manned by crew members. No one else is allowed in the boat.
- 3. Each race craft must be propelled exclusively by paddle power. Outside assistance or ground support cannot aid in the forward progress of a boat. Overland portage is not allowed.
- 4. Crew members will need to bring a PFD (personal flotation device). Crew members must wear a PFD. No boat will be allowed to start unless all crew members are wearing a PFD. All participants that operate the boats must be able to swim.
- 5. The crew compartment CANNOT be enclosed so as to interfere with escape if the boat becomes a submarine. Crew members must be visible at all times during the race.
- 6. Boat themes, team costumes and decorations are welcome and encouraged, but they must be safe and NOT hinder the flotation of their boat or any other racing craft. No loose items, especially items that can sink, are allowed on board. No sharp edges or pointy things allowed.
- 7. All crew members enter this race at their own risk and will not hold this event's organizers, judges, officials, sponsors liable for accidents, injuries, damages, etc. All crew members must sign a Liability Waiver before the race. Crew members must be at least 18 years of age unless accompanied by their parent/legal guardian. Accompanied minors may not be less than 14 years of age. You CANNOT race without signed waivers.
- 8. All participants in this event agree to appear in any event-related media coverage free of charge.
- 9. Any participant thought to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be prohibited from participating in the race. Any behavior that is deemed to be detrimental to the event or other participants will result in team disqualification. In the case of a dispute, determinations will be made by race officials. Boats and teams may be disqualified for violation of any rules at the discretion of race officials. Race officials decide on the interpretation of the rules.
- 10. The HARP Authority, in its sole judgment, may bar from participation any boat or crew member the HARP Authority deems not compliant with the rules of the event.



## Build Your Own Boat Race Construction & Design Rules

- 1. Design is left to the boat building teams. Uniqueness and creativity are highly encouraged.
- 2. Inner tubes can be used in the construction of the watercraft, but must not be the only component of the watercraft.
- 3. All boats must be built by the designated four (4) team members.
- 4. All boats must be propelled exclusively by paddle power. No motorized or electric power propellants are allowed.
- 5. No pre-manufactured motor, paddle or bicycle boats allowed.
- 6. Anything other than minor fixes to the boats will not be allowed on race day.
- 7. Sunken or discarded parts of boats must be disposed of in designated trash receptacles. This is the team's responsibility.
- 8. All boats are subject to pre-race inspection by race officials.

# Build Your Own Boat Race Awards & Judging Criteria

Each of the award-winning teams will be presented with a trophy

### The Prestige Worldwide Award

Judges will award to the team that finishes the race in 1st place in accordance with the race rules.

### The Sailor Swift Award

Judges will award to the team that finishes the race in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in accordance with the race rules.


### The SeaWorthy Award
